 Regional Fund Allocation Proposal and Approval Process for 2016

1. WDC/ROC receive overview of SWP legislative/CCCCO requirements
  - a) Regional Flow chart
  - b) CCCCCO template/application
2. ROC recommends regional strategic workforce development priority projects for utilizing the SWP funds and communicates their decision to WDC
3. WDC meets to review regional strategic workforce development priority projects and assigns development of proposals.
4. WDC meets to review proposals; voting members, through majority vote, recommend funding; WDC forwards draft proposals to ROC and Leadership Team.
5. ROC and Leadership Team review draft proposals and recommend approval.
6. WDC submits summary recommendation to SDICCCA and recommends approval of projects at the SDICCCA December 2016 meeting
