- Data/Research. T. Ngo Bartel presented the second draft of the Labor Market Analysis report at
 the WDC retreat on 2.23.18. A full copy of the report can be found at

 also been created and is available. The next Data/Research committee meeting will be held on
 3.14.18 at Miramar College; all are invited to attend.
- Regional projects recommendations: M. Smith and D. Brown shared the SWP Regional
 Comprehensive Recommendations. These recommendations will guide the development of
 individual regional projects that will provide the framework of the 17/18 and 18/19 Strong
 Workforce plans. Successful implementation of the SWP will require leadership at all of the
 campuses to guide the work.
- Individual projects and 17-18 budget preparation: The 17/18 application and budget is due by 3.31.18.
- Operational structure for SWP implementation: In an effort to align the strengths of the regional leadership with SWP implementation, M. Smith proposed reinstating the dean's meeting to precede the full WDC meeting open to all constituents.
