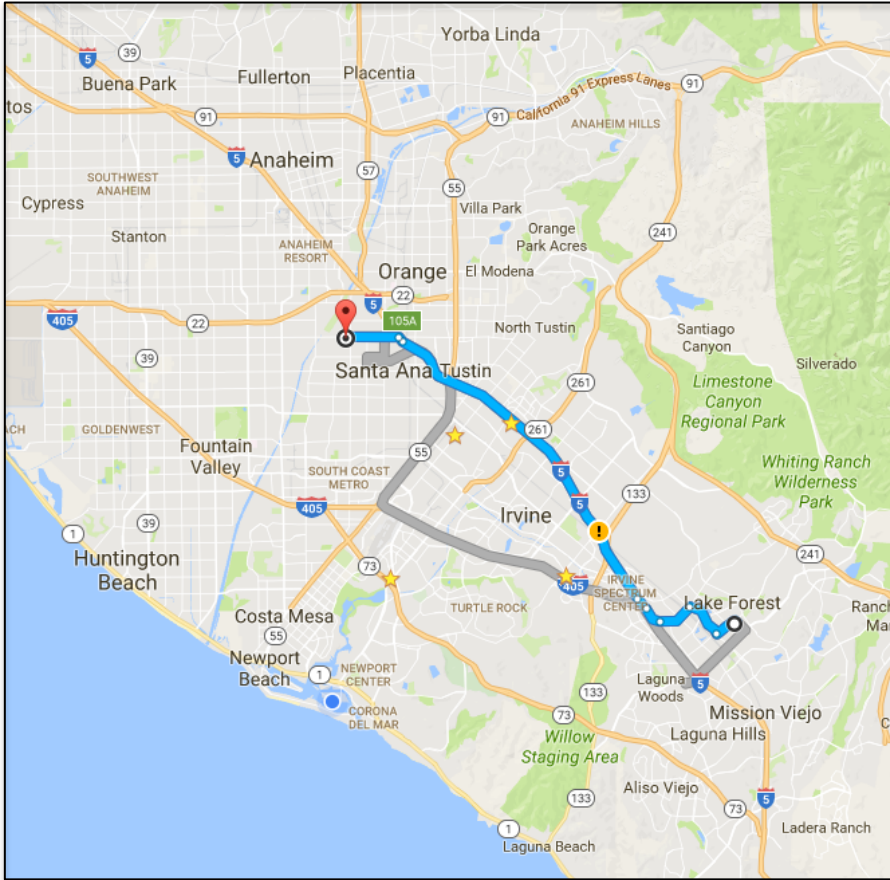
Pharmacy Technician Named One of 15 Best Jobs
