CTE Tutoring Workgroup

Project Purpose:

Faculty and students in the Region indicated that their unique CTE tutoring needs are not being met. This impacts student retention, completion, persistence and success. Ultimately, this results in a decreased number of students graduating and entering the workforce. Inquiry into the specific needs and barriers for CTE tutoring have not been assessed and thus the first stage to improve these outcomes is researching the current state and successful models of learning support. From this research, recommendations will be brought forward for consideration of improvement in CTE Tutoring in the Region.

Project to Date:

- Summer - 2018 USD Non-Profit Institute was hired to conduct the research under the guidance of the workgroup.
- Summer and Fall 2018 - Individual interviews with Workgroup member were performed to collect initial data.
- Fall 2018 - Six focus groups were conducted in the region with CTE Students, faculty and tutors.
- Fall 2018 - Survey develop based on the interviews and focus group data.

Survey Information:

- The survey is for CTE Students, CTE Faculty/Staff, and Tutors.
- This is one survey that branches using skip logic based on the participant's status and responses.
- The survey will open on 1/22 and close on 2/19. Individual campus launches may depend on when the semester begins.
- The participants will be invited to complete the survey through emails and social media marketing. This will be coordinated through the individual campus CTE Dean/Associate Dean.
- The email invitations will be customized to the audience even though the link is to the same URL.
